

INCI Information for LabColors

Some soap makers choose to list their ingredients on labels while others choose not to. This seems to be a controversial issue due to the Soap Exemption in the U.S.

We have included **the proper INCI Label info for the dye portion of your soap** if you choose to use them. It is up to you to place them in the order they are used on your label. This position should be at or near the end of your label.

For everything other than soap, you will be required to list your ingredients, i.e., lotions and creams. This information is in compliance for North America and is not for use in Japan or the European Union.

Changes for the Year 2000:

You will notice that the prefixes D&C, FD&C and the No. preceding the colour number are no longer required. These changes are in effect as of January 1, 2000. This information was obtained from Introduction to The International Cosmetic Ingredient Dictionary and Handbook 8th Edition 2000 published by the Cosmetic, Toiletry and Fragrance Association.
